Background

The construction of the Pre-Primary Unit commenced on 1st April, 2022 and it took three and half months to completion.

The school is painted in dark grey walls with white pillars. The facility has a well-equipped playground, a kitchen and dining area, modern toilets for girls, boys and the physically challenged, PP1 & PP2 classrooms fully equipped with children's' furniture, teacher's desk and all learning materials. The administration block is also geared towards ensuring all furniture is in place prior to the school opening day.

The school is fenced and has a metal main gate to ensure security for the children. The area is surrounded with a well maintained garden.

Staffing and Implications

The implications of this project are far greater therefore in order to bring out quality out of the modern institution: -

- Qualified teachers fully trained in the Competency Based Curriculum (CBC) and other qualified staff who successfully pass the interview to be deployed.
- Maintain the institution's vision is to produce the best of individuals from a very young age.
- Promote quality learning environment and experiences throughout the study period of the child.
- Current number of children enrolled in the Pre Primary unit is 50 students.
- Expected rise of intake in the near future once we show case quality learning standards
- Promoting child growth through play facilities and a feeding program.
