Qurbani goats were distributed in:

15 BMMKenya Centres = 525 goats 36 independent Centres = 353 goats

The day of **Eid-ul-Adha** falls on the tenth day in the final (twelfth) month of the Islamic Lunar Calendar; Dhu-al-Hijjah. The day that celebrations fall on, depends on a legitimate sighting of the moon, following the completion of the annual Holy Pilgrimage of Hajj - which is an obligation for all Muslim's. Bilal Muslim Mission of Kenya celebrated the auspicious day in all its' 15 centers and 40 adjacent Shia Independent centers around coastal region and upcountry.





Activities that took place during Eid Al-adha include;

- 1. Eid Prayers led by different Imams in all centers.
- 2. Lectures to commemorate Prophet Ibrahim's devotion sacrifice his son, Ismail with its relevance to the Muslin
- 3. Qur'bani (Sacrifice) to mark Prophet Ibrahim's a.s sacr
- 4. Distribution of packed Qurbanis meat to the believers friends and orphanage.
- 5. Some Centers had home visits for dua recitation for those faced with illness.





With the generous support and assistance received from various organizations and donors, Bilal Muslim Mission of Kenya was able to provide 878 goats in total to various regions namely; 525 to 15 BMMK centres and 353 goats to 36 Shia Independent centres, including Lamu, Malindi and Kilifi.
