The physical, psychological and instructional atmosphere in a classroom constitute the learning environment which has been proven to significantly impact student achievement and is closely linked to student success.

With regard to the physical atmosphere, The Bilal Muslim Mission of Kenya perceived the need to improve the Pre-primary classrooms at the centres we manage. With generous support from donors, 145 new student tables and 423 new student chairs were acquired in the month of March 2023 for 9 locations.

The existing wooden desks were outdated and uncomfortable. In some centres, there was an insufficient amount of classroom furniture and some young scholars would be found seated on the floor.







In contrast the new furniture is colourful, attractive and comfortable. Almost every learner at the centres that benefitted from this initiative now has a new comfortable chair to sit in. Furthermore, the teachers also received new furniture inclusive of an extra chair for visitors. 20 tables with a set of 2 chairs each were purchased for this purpose.
