

COMPLETION REPORT FOR THE EXTENSION OF THE LADIES PRAYER HALL FOR SAMBURU CENTRE

The Mission embarked on the extension of the ladies prayer hall to enable the ladies to acquire more space to hold their prayers. This is because from the statistics, it had been noticed that the number of Ladies compared to men is high, especially during the Friday Prayers. Some of the ladies were forced to hold their prayers outside during the Friday Prayers.

The extension measuring 10 meters by 4.5 meters has been done to increase space. The steps involved to completion are:-

SUBSTRUCTURE WORKS

This involved the setting out of the extension, the excavation of the foundation trenches up to the concreting of the Foundation slab.

SUPERSTRUCTURE WORKS

This involved laying of the superstructure block work up to and including the roofing works. The finished extension is complete with electricity that is the lighting system as well as sockets. The roof is fixed with translucent sheets at intervals to allow in enough light during the day.
