

## DISTRIBUTION OF LEARNING MATERIALS

It is reported that we have approximately 3.6 Million orphans in Kenya aged below 18 years. This is the most vulnerable group and in dire need. We at Bilal Muslim Mission of Kenya offer various support such as: Education assistance, Medical Support, Ration packs, housing repairs and maintenance and clothing to orphans residing in the 15 Rural Centers. However outreach of such support is low due to unavailability of sufficient financial aid.

In September 2022, with the generous support provided by WF-AID, Bilal Muslim Mission of Kenya was able to provide a pack of stationery and other basic school items to seven orphans.



### Package Contents:

Each package distributed consisted of:

- 2 sets of Full School Uniform.
- Some of the Stationery items provided were: Revision Text Books & Set books, Exercise books, pens, pencils, Calculator, Geometrical Set
- School bag, Shoes, Shoe polish, Mosquito Net, P.E Uniform.
- A kit of personal Items.

## Beneficiary Details:

1. **AHMED KASSIM**- He is an orphan whose father passed away a month before he was born in 2003 and has been raised by his mother. He has grown up with 3 siblings, one who is in primary school, one in university currently receiving sponsorship from the Bilal Kenya and the older brother, a Madrassah Teacher who is the breadwinner of the family. Ahmed is currently in Form Two (Secondary Level).



2. **JAMILA RAMADHAN** –born in 2007 and currently in Form One. She has 6 siblings; 2 in secondary school and the rest in primary school level. Her father who was their breadwinner passed away 3 years ago. Jamila’s mother depends on small businesses of cooking for school kids in order to acquire their daily upkeep. 2 of her siblings and herself are beneficiaries under the Missions Education Sponsorship Program for Orphans.



3. **BILAL WANDO** – This boy was born in 2007 and stays with guardians after one parent passed and the other got paralyzed. He has 3 siblings; 1 of which has completed primary school level and 2 have completed secondary school but could not proceed to technical institutions due to financial problems.





4. **HASSAN OMAR**- he is 14 years old and has been raised by his mother. Hassan has 5 siblings, one in secondary school, and the other 4 in primary school level. Hassan is in Form 1. His mother mostly depends on the earnings she gets by working in a nearby sisal factory to provide for the daily needs of her family

5. **SHAMIM KEMUNTO**-

She is aged 16 years, currently in form 1, and has no siblings. Her mother is a growing entrepreneur- a salonist and depends on her business to provide for her family

6. **SUMMEIYA ALI** – The student was born in 2006, she has 6 siblings, 1 in secondary school and the rest in primary. She is currently in Form 2. Since the demise of her father, the mother has been selling juice for upkeep.



7. **SAUMU NAWIRE**-she is the last born in a family of 7. The rest of the siblings are out of school. Her mother does casual jobs to support her family
