Pedagogy training for muballighs

A pilot program on Pedagogy training was offered to all muballighs at Al-Mahdi Centre in Samburu, Al-Hujjah Centre in Chengoni and Jaffery Centre at Mackinnon Road and nearby independent centres between October and December 2024. This comprised on-site refresher and training programs on modern teaching methodologies in madrasa. Based on the evaluation results, the program will be expanded to include all Bilal and Bilal-supported independent centres in the new year
